- 4. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/Bid Security: It is Rs.14,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Thousand only) either in the form of a Demand Draft from any schedule bank, drawn in favour of Director, NCPOR, payable at Vasco-Da-Gama, Goa or from any reputed bank (scheduled bank) initially valid for 180 days from the date of closing tender as per the Annexure-VIII.

Bids received without EMD will be rejected outright.

9) Undue profiteering:

Controlled Price, if any or MRP: The price quoted by Bidder shall not be higher than the controlled price fixed by law for the Goods, if any, or where there is no controlled price, it shall not exceed the prices or contravene the norms for fixation of prices if any, laid down by Government or where the Government has fixed no such prices or norms, it shall not exceed the price appearing in any agreement, if any, relating to price regulation by any industry.
